

Cookies Policy

When you enter the website of the Motor Insurers' Bureau - Greece (www.mib-hellas.gr), you are informed about the existence of cookies with a pop-up banner. The use of the website www.mib-hellas.gr entails that you accept the use of cookies in accordance with the current policy.

1. What cookies are

Cookies are small pieces of information (files) stored on your computer (or other web-enabled devices, such as smartphones or tablets), when you visit a Website. Their main function is to memorize information for a certain period, in order to facilitate the browsing of each visitor on the websites of his choice.

2. Why we use cookies

We use cookies to facilitate the use of our website and improve your experience on it. The Motor Insurers' Bureau-Greece cannot verify your personal identity from this information.

3. Types of cookies we use on this website

The Motor Insurers' Bureau-Greece, the Controller of the website, uses only the necessary cookies to support the operation of the website and promote better browsing. It is noted that third parties have no access to these cookies.

Necessary cookies

In particular, the necessary cookies, otherwise the absolutely required cookies, are of essential importance for the proper functioning of our website and the connection to it. They allow you to browse and use its features. These cookies do not recognize your personal identity and without them the effective operation of the website is not possible.
